About the GMAT® Exam

The Graduate Management Admission Test® (GMAT® Exam) examination is a standardized test designed to measure an aspirants' aptitude for business studies at graduate school. This test has been administered, for over 50 years, in more than 150 countries around the world by the GMAC (Graduate Management Admission Council).

GMAT® Exam score is based on a range of 200 (minimum) to 800 (maximum). The scoring pattern is on an increment of 10 points.

The exam is administered round the year, except Sundays and National Holidays. To register for the exam student has to visit www.mba.com. Exam fees for GMAT® Exam is USD 250, however to change date or venue candidate has to pay \$50. The change of date or venue is possible before 7 days of test taking date. GMAT® Exam score is valid for 5 years. Students now will be able to view their unofficial GMAT score prior to making a decision to accept or cancel them.

GMAT® Exam allows candidate to send score at 5 B-Schools / programs after administering the test and before getting the final scores. Further payment of US\$28 should be made to send scores at additional B-schools. It is recommended that test takers should decide which schools they wish to apply even before appearing for the test during the preparation of exam. GMAT® Exam score comes after in 21 working days. (However raw score of IR, Verbal and Quant immediately after the exam).

GMAT® Exam can be taken 5 times in a year with a gap of minimum 16 days. Passport is mandatory to take the GMAT® Exam.

Any score above 700 is considered as good score.

Who is Eligible to write GMAT® exam:

Graduates, Undergraduates and working professionals.

The ideal time to start GMAT® Exam preparation is minimum one year prior to the intake dates.

Here's how it works:

- If a test taker accepts their scores, the official report will be sent to the schools they selected.
- In addition, If the test taker cancels the score there is no report which is generated, however the test taker can reinstate their scores within 60 days from the date of their exam for a fee of USD\$100.

If you accepted your scores, please pick up a printed copy of your unofficial score report at front desk. This contains an authentication code that you will need to access for your Official scores. Please note: This is the only time you will receive this code.

What is a Computer Adaptive Test?

Computer Adaptive Test is a test which indicates that the test adapts itself to the correctness / in correctness of your responses. The first few questions in Verbal Ability and Quantitative sections are of moderate difficulty. With correct responses, the level of difficulty increases, and conversely - with incorrect responses the level of difficulty decreases. The score does not depend only on the number of correct and incorrect answers. It also depends on the difficulty level of the questions encountered. The weightage for tougher questions is more than for the easier questions. The test is administered on the computer and the questions have to be tackled in the order in which they appear; you cannot skip a question. Neither can you revert to an earlier question to change the answer. However Integrated Reasoning is not computer adaptive. It is essential that all questions are completed as there is a heavy penalty for the questions not attempted. These factors make time management very critical in GMAT® Exam.

Details of the GMAT® Exam

1. AWA - Analytical Writing Assessment

The task is that of analysing an argument, which is presented as a short passage that the test-taker has to evaluate and present his/her critique. The test-taker does not require any in-depth knowledge of the argument topic, but the test taker's capacity to write analytically is assessed.

- Time - 30 min
- Score Range - 0-6

2. Integrated Reasoning (IR) Section

The four question types in the IR section are:

- (a) **Graphic Interpretation** that tests ability to understand graphs and draw inferences from them.
 - (b) **Two Part Analysis** that measures ability to understand relationship between two entities.
 - © **Multi-Source reasoning** that measures ability to assimilate information from multiple sources of information. The sources can be tables, graphs, emails etc.
 - (d) **Table Analysis** that presents questions based on a sortable data table.
 - On screen calculator will be provided for this section only.
- Time - 30 min
 - Number of questions - 12
 - Scale score - 1-8

3. Quantitative Section

There are two types of multiple choice questions in this section. The questions are intermingled throughout the section.

- (a) Problem Solving
 - (b) Data Sufficiency
- Time - 75 mins
 - Number of questions - 37
 - Scale score - 0-60

4. Verbal Section

There are three types of multiple choice questions in this section:-

- (a) Reading Comprehension
 - (b) Critical Reasoning
 - (c) Sentence Correction
- Time - 75 mins
 - Number of questions - 41
 - Scale score - 0-60

It is offered by the MIT - Sloan School of Management, The London School of Business and The Stanford- Graduates School of Business.



Masters in Management - Management Programme for Freshers

(Work experience between 0-2 years')

Masters in Management (MIM) is a postgraduate programme in general management. It is an ideal course for fresh graduates and anyone within the age group of 21-24 years. One can take up this course directly after graduation without any work experience. MIM is usually a shorter duration programme that lasts anywhere between 12 and 20 months. Europe is the most proliferating geographic area for Masters in Management. However, with an increasing demand for the program, USA and some Asian countries have also started offering this programme. MIM course fees are much less than that of an MBA programme.

The MIM course portfolio covers a broad range of business topics like Marketing, Project Management, Human Resources Management, IT Management, etc. MIM curriculum contains personal development and leadership courses as well as seminars, case studies and teamwork sessions for the same.

Masters in Management qualifies candidates to become professional managers. Besides garnering the knowledge, leadership skills, and international experience, one would also have the opportunity to apply them in a real-world business environment.

To apply for an MIM programme, one should have a Bachelor's degree along with the required GMAT® Exam score and the requisite English language skills.

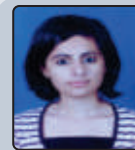

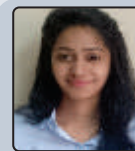
