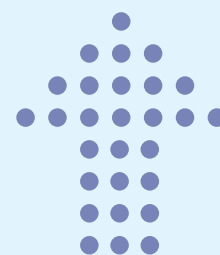

B-School selection process - What do they test?

The selection process generally consists of two stages:

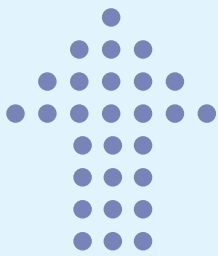
1) Computer-based Examination of about 1-3 hours

Multiple choice and fill in the blank questions, often with negative marking.

Areas tested: Verbal Ability, Reading Comprehension, Logical Reasoning, Quantitative Ability, Data Interpretation, General Knowledge and Current Affairs (GK is tested in exams like XAT, MAT, CMAT, etc. CAT does not test aspirants on GK).

2) Group Discussion (GD), Written Ability Test (WAT) and Personal Interview (PI).

Most B-Schools shortlist applicants based on their performance in the written test. Selected candidates will then face the Group Discussion/Written Ability Test and Personal Interview rounds. Some B-Schools also use other activities like Group Tasks, Case Studies, Extempore and Group Interviews to assess subject knowledge, communication skills, managerial skills and to check confidence levels and attitude of the applicants.



How do you get into India's Top B-Schools?

Admission into over 90+ management institutes, apart from the IIMs, is based on the Common Admission Test (CAT) conducted by the IIMs. This includes a majority of the top 100 B-Schools of India. This makes CAT the 'Holy Grail' for every MBA aspirant.

The expressway to an Ivy League School

- Most top-notch institutes shortlist candidates based on CAT scores
- Some also conduct their own admission tests, like XAT, SNAP, etc.

B-Schools may use the score of more than one entrance test to short-list candidates. Some of the major entrance tests are:

Common Admission Test (CAT): This is conducted by the IIMs. Prominent B-Schools that accept the CAT score include the 21 IIMs, FMS Delhi, IIFT, MDI Gurgaon, SPJIMR Mumbai, Schools of Management (SoMs) at various IITs viz., Delhi, Bombay, Chennai, Kharagpur, Kanpur, Roorkee, Dhanbad, Jodhpur and Guwahati, MICA Ahmedabad, IMT Ghaziabad, etc.

Xavier Aptitude Test (XAT): Conducted by XLRI Jamshedpur & Delhi. Apart from XLRI, other top B-Schools such as Xavier University Bhubaneswar, Goa Institute of Management (GIM), IMT Ghaziabad, MICA Ahmedabad, etc. also accept the XAT score.

Symbiosis National Aptitude Test (SNAP): Conducted by Symbiosis International University (deemed to be) and accepted by the B-Schools affiliated to it including Symbiosis Institute of Business Management (SIBM) Pune, Symbiosis Centre of Management & Human Resources Development (SCMHRD) Pune, Symbiosis Institute of International Business (SIIB), Symbiosis Institute of Business Management (SIBM) Bengaluru, etc.

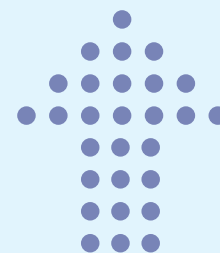
NMAT by GMAC: The scores of NMAT, conducted by GMAC, are accepted by NMIMS Mumbai / Hyderabad / Bangalore / Navi Mumbai / Indore, XUB, IBS, etc. NMAT is conducted in the Computer Adaptive Test (CAT) format in a window of about three months.

Common Management Admission Test (CMAT): Conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA). The score is accepted by a large number of B-Schools across the country.

Management Aptitude Test (MAT): Conducted by All-India Management Association (AIMA). A large number of B-Schools across the country accept this test score.

- Some B-Schools conduct their own tests. E.g. IBSAT for ICFAI Group of Business Schools etc.

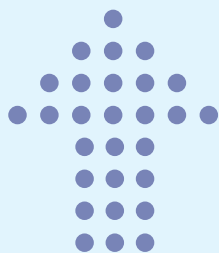

Facing the CAT:

Q. Can you tell me more about the pattern of the CAT ?

- A. The total duration of CAT 2023 was two hours. There were three sections, and each section had a sectional time limit of 40 minutes each. Following were the three sections:

Section - 1: Verbal Ability & Reading Comprehension (VARC) - 24 Questions

Section - 2: Data Interpretation & Logical Reasoning (DILR) - 20 Questions

Section - 3: Quantitative Ability (QA) - 22 Questions

CAT authorities are known to update the pattern every few years. The pattern of CAT had no changes from 2016-2019. The number of questions and the sectional time limit was reduced in CAT 2020 considering the pandemic. There was a further reduction of questions in CAT 2021, though the duration of the exam remained the same as that of CAT 2020. There was no change in the pattern for CAT 2022 and CAT 2023. Pattern for CAT 2024 could, hence, be different from what was seen in CAT 2022/2023, but is expected to be on similar lines overall. We will get better clarity on the pattern of CAT 2024 once the CAT notification is released in July-Aug 2024.

Q. What are the eligibility criteria for CAT?

- A. The following is the eligibility criteria:
- Bachelor's Degree, with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA [45% in case of candidates belonging to SC, ST, PWD categories]
 - Candidates appearing for the final year of Bachelor's degree/ equivalent qualification examination and those who completed degree requirements and are awaiting results could also apply.

Q. What criteria should you seek to find a trusted and effective CAT training institute?

- A. We encourage you to dig deep into the claims of the institutes that you are considering. Newspapers are full of tall, often

misleading claims and inflated admission numbers achieved. We advise students to ask questions, find out the details and truly understand the institution's reputation.

Q. You say that 2805 T.I.M.E. students have made it through CAT 2022, and they secured 10,892 final selections into 13 IIMs for which the results are publicly available. What does this mean?

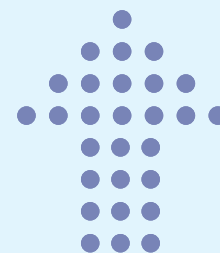
- A. A large number of students get final selections into more than one IIM. If you count the number of final selections secured by T.I.M.E. students in the 13 IIMs in CAT 2022, it adds up to 10,892. However, this number was achieved by 2805 students! Do not get confused between 'calls' and 'selections'. 'Calls' is a term used to indicate short-lists for the GD/PI round. What really matters is the 'final selection' into the IIMs.

Q. What kind of salary can I expect on graduating from a top B-School?

- A. Salaries on campus depend on the academic performance (during MBA) and the candidate's profile. The salary figures of top-rung schools like IIM-A / IIM-B / IIM-C / IIM-L / XLRI / FMS / SP Jain, etc. can be in the range of Rs. 30 LPA to over 1 CPA.
- Even at around 80%ile (40,000 to 50,000 rank) one could get into an institute that would fetch a job offering of Rs.10-15 Lakhs per annum.
 - The most important thing to remember is that an MBA from a decent B-School would invariably lead to a spike in your earning potential. All you need to do is gain admission into the right B-School.

Q. What is the weightage given to the factors within a candidate's control i.e., CAT, GD, WAT & PI?

- A. Most IIMs have at least 60% weightage assigned to the above parameters. Past Academics are not always as critical. Similarly, not having work experience should not be a cause of worry as a good chunk of students at the topmost B-Schools are freshers.



CAT immediately after college? Or work experience first?

Doing an MBA immediately after your graduation will be more valuable for your career growth.

Q. Is it really better to first get a few years of work experience and then prepare for CAT?

A. The answer is NO. Sample a scenario: Mohan is an engineering student in the final year of college who has been selected by a leading IT firm in the country. He is really confused if he should attempt the CAT now or get two years of experience first, and then attempt it. Now consider the following:

Assuming the fee of the college he would get into two years later does not go up, he is effectively choosing between making 12.6 lakhs in 2 years and then doing an MBA, or, doing an MBA first, and then making 52.5 lakhs in two years. Clearly, Mohan would have earned more if he went for an MBA first.

- The fee for the B-School has been assumed to remain the same. However, it is likely to go up with every passing year.
- For getting a promotion, his work experience as an MBA would be more relevant and valuable.
- If he wrote the CAT as a fresher and things did not go his way, he could always attempt it a second time.
- With a job, it would be difficult for him to start his preparation for an entrance test, as his job wouldn't leave him with much time.
- If he has prepared earlier, he can definitely find time to brush up his concepts but not otherwise.
- Most importantly, the amount of post-MBA learning that Mohan would have got on the job would be many times more than the learning that he would have got by working pre-MBA.

To top this, the learning being of higher quality, it will be aligned to the kind of work that Mohan is expected to be doing, going forward in his career.

- If we look at the weightage given to work experience in the IIMs, it's not more than 10% for most of the IIMs. So, it's not as much of a difference as it is hyped up to be.
- Even during the placements at a B-School, the added incentive for every year of work-experience is not much in monetary terms.

Q. Is it necessary to choose MBA Specialization at the time of application itself?

A. No, in most cases it is not required. Most management institutes offer general management courses. In this kind of course, a student learns the basics of all functional areas, viz. Marketing, Finance, Human Resources, Systems and Operations, during the first year. In the second year, there is an option of choosing subjects depending on one's area of interest.

Q. What is the difference between MBA and PGPM/PGDM?

- A. When an institute is an autonomous body (meaning it is not affiliated to any university) and conducts management courses, then such an Institute cannot offer an MBA degree. Instead, it awards a Post-Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM) or a Post-Graduate Diploma in Business Administration (PGDBA). Only universities (foreign or Indian) and the IIMs (under the IIM Act) can grant an MBA degree. MDI Gurgaon, SPJIMR Mumbai, XLRI, etc. offer a diploma.
- However, students are advised to bear in mind that the value of the management course pursued by them does not depend on whether it is a 'Degree' or a 'Diploma', rather, it depends on the reputation and standing of the institute that is offering the Degree or Diploma.

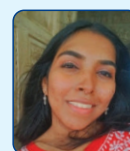
