About CSAT

The Civil Services Aptitude Test (CSAT) is held by Union Public Service Commission (UPSC), for the selection of candidates for Civil Services (Mains) Examination. The examination is conducted once every year in accordance with the rules published by the Department of Personnel & Training. There are 24 services (or posts) to which recruitment is finally made, through this two stage examination process (i.e CSAT followed by Mains examination). These 24 services include, 2 All India Services, 17 Group A services, and 5 Group B services. The services which come within All India Services are Indian Administrative Service (IAS) and Indian Police Service (IPS).

The services which come within **Group A** are Indian Foreign Service, Indian Audit and Accounts Service, Indian Revenue Service (Customs and Central Excise), Indian Defence Accounts Service, Indian Postal Service etc. The services which come within **Group B** are Pondicherry Civil Service, Pondicherry Police Service, etc.

The number of vacancies corresponding to these 24 services (or posts) is liable to change every year. For example, in year 2004, the number of vacancies was 453 and it was increased to a 1079 for the year 2016.

CSAT 2016 Exam will be conducted on 7th August 2016.

Eligibility

Following are the eligibility requirements to sit for the Civil Services Examination:

- The aspirant needs to be of Indian Nationality.
- The age limit is 21 to 32 years for general category test takers, 21 to 35 years for OBC candidates, and 21 to 37 years for SC / ST candidates, as on 1st August of the year of the exam.
- The minimum educational qualification is a graduate degree from a recognized university. However, candidates who are in the final year are also eligible to apply for and appear in the preliminary exam.
- The number of attempts is limited to six for general candidates and nine for OBC candidates. There are no such limits for SC / ST candidates. An attempt is counted whenever a candidate appears for the preliminary examination.

Selection Process

The selection process consists of two successive stages:

Stage 1: Civil Services (Preliminary) Examination (Objective Type) for the selection of candidates for Main Examination.

Stage 2: Civil Services (Main) Examination (Written and Interview) for the selection of candidates for the various services and posts.



Introduction to Civil Services Aptitude Test (CSAT)

In 2011, the preliminary section of the civil services examination witnessed the following changes:

- Removal of the optional subject
- Introduction of Civil Services Aptitude Test
- Provision of equal weightage to both papers
 - Paper I - 200 Marks
 - Paper II - 200 Marks

These changes are expected to offer a level playing field to all the candidates, as the previous process favoured students of popular subjects.
