B-SCHOOL SELECTION PROCESS - WHAT DO THEY TEST?

The selection process generally consists of two stages:

1. Computer-based Examination of about 1-3 hours

Areas tested: Verbal Ability, Reading Comprehension, Logical Reasoning, Quantitative Ability, Data Interpretation, General Knowledge, and Current Affairs (GK is tested in exams like XAT, MAT, CMAT, etc. CAT does not test aspirants on GK).

2. Group Discussion (GD), Written Ability Test (WAT) and Personal Interview (PI)

Most B-Schools shortlist applicants based on their performance in the written test. Selected candidates will then face the Group Discussion/Written Ability Test and Personal Interview rounds. Some B-Schools also use other activities like Group Tasks, Case Studies, Extempore and Group Interviews to assess subject knowledge, communication skills, managerial skills and to check confidence levels and attitude of the applicants.



HOW DO YOU GET INTO INDIA'S TOP B-SCHOOLS?

Admission into over 90+ management institutes, apart from the IIMs, is based on the Common Admission Test (CAT) conducted by the IIMs. This includes a majority of the top 100 B-Schools of India. This makes CAT the 'Holy Grail' for every MBA aspirant.

Common Admission Test (CAT):

This is conducted by the IIMs. Prominent B-Schools that accept the CAT score include the 21 IIMs, FMS Delhi, TISS Mumbai, IIFT, MDI Gurgaon, SPJIMR Mumbai, Schools of Management (SoMs) at various IITs viz., Delhi, Bombay, Chennai, Kharagpur, Kanpur, Roorkee, Dhanbad, Jodhpur and Guwahati, MICA Ahmedabad, IMT Ghaziabad, etc.

Xavier Aptitude Test (XAT):

Conducted by XLRI Jamshedpur & Delhi. Apart from XLRI, other top B-Schools such as Xavier University Bhubaneswar, Goa Institute of Management (GIM), IMT Ghaziabad, MICA Ahmedabad, etc. also accept the XAT score.

Symbiosis National Aptitude Test (SNAP):

Conducted by Symbiosis International University (deemed to be) and accepted by the B-Schools affiliated to it including Symbiosis Institute of Business Management (SIBM) Pune, Symbiosis Centre of Management & Human Resources Development (SCMHRD) Pune, Symbiosis Institute of International Business (SIB), Symbiosis Institute of Business Management (SIBM) Bengaluru, etc.

NMAT by GMAC:

The scores of NMAT, conducted by GMAC, are accepted by NMIMS (Mumbai and all the other campuses), XUB, IBS, etc. NMAT is conducted in the Computer Adaptive Test (CAT) format in a window of about three months.

Common Management Admission Test (CMAT):

Conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA). The score is accepted by a large number of B-Schools across the country.

Management Aptitude Test (MAT):

Conducted by All-India Management Association (AIMA). A large number of B-Schools across the country accept this test score.

Some B-Schools conduct their own tests. E.g. IBSAT for ICFAI Group of Business Schools, etc.

FREQUENTLY ASKED **QUESTIONS**

Facing the CAT:

Q. Can you tell me more about the pattern of the CAT?

A. The total duration of CAT 2024 was two hours. There were three sections, and each section had a sectional time limit of 40 minutes. Following were the three sections:

Section - 1: Verbal Ability & Reading Comprehension (VARC) - 24 Questions

Section - 2: Data Interpretation & Logical Reasoning (DILR) - 22 Questions

Section - 3: Quantitative Ability (QA) - 22 Questions

CAT authorities are known to update the pattern every few years. We will get better clarity on the pattern of CAT 2025 once the CAT notification is released in July-Aug 2025.

Q. What are the eligibility criteria for CAT?

- A. The following is the eligibility criteria:
- Bachelor's Degree, with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA [45% in case of candidates belonging to SC, ST, PWD categories]
- Candidates appearing for the final year of Bachelor's degree/equivalent qualification examination and those who completed degree requirements and are awaiting results could also apply.

Q. You say that 2565 **T.I.M.E.** students have made it through CAT 2023, and they secured 11,766 final selections into 13 IIMs for which the results are publicly available. What does this mean?

A. A large number of students get final selections into more than one IIM. If you count the number of final selections secured by **T.I.M.E.** students in the 13 IIMs in CAT 2023, it adds up to 11,766. However, this number was achieved by 2565 students! Do not get confused between 'calls' and 'selections'. 'Calls' is a term used to indicate short-lists for the GD/PI round. What matters is the 'final selection' into the IIMs.

Q. What kind of salary can I expect on graduating from a top B-School?

- **A.** Salaries on campus depend on the academic performance (during MBA) and the candidate's profile. The salary figures of top-rung schools like IIM-A/IIM-B/IIM-C/IIM-L/XLRI/FMS/SP Jain, etc. can be in the range of ₹30 Lakhs per annum to over ₹1 Crore per annum.
- Even at around 80%ile (40,000 to 50,000 rank) one could get into an institute that would fetch a job offering of ₹10-15 Lakhs per annum.
- The most important thing to remember is that an MBA from a decent B-School would invariably lead to a spike in your earning potential. All you need to do is gain admission into the right B-School.

Q. What is the weightage given to the factors within a candidate's control i.e., CAT, GD, WAT & PI?

A. Most IIMs have at least 60% weight-age assigned to the above parameters. Past Academics are not always as critical. Similarly, not having experience should not be a cause of worry as a good chunk of students at the topmost B-Schools are freshers.



Doing an MBA immediately after your graduation will be more valuable for your career growth.

Q. Is it really better to first get a few years of work experience and then prepare for CAT?

A. The answer is NO. Sample a scenario: Mohan is an engineering student in the final year of college who has been selected by a leading IT firm in the country. He is really confused if he should attempt the CAT now or get two years of experience first and then attempt it. Now consider the following:

Assuming the fee of the college he would get into two years later does not go up, he is effectively choosing between making ₹12.6 lakhs in 2 years and then doing an MBA, or, doing an MBA first, and then making ₹52.5 lakhs in two years. Clearly, Mohan would have earned more if he went for an MBA first.

- Most importantly, the amount of post-MBA learning that Mohan would have got on the job would be many times more than the learning that he would have got by working pre-MBA. To top this, the learning being of higher quality, it will be aligned to the kind of work that Mohan is expected to be doing, going forward in his career.
- If we look at the weightage given to work experience in the IIMs, it's not more than 10% for most of the IIMs. So, it's not as much of a difference as it is hyped up to be.

Choosing the right training institute for CAT

Q. What criteria should you seek to find a trusted and effective CAT training institute?

A. We encourage you to dig deep into the claims of the institutes that you are considering. Newspapers and digital platforms are full of tall, often misleading claims and inflated admission numbers achieved. We advise students to ask questions, find out the details and truly understand the institution's reputation.

Q. Many free / cheap CAT-prep resources are available online. Why should I join T.I.M.E.?

A. CAT is not a percentage-based exam but a percentile-based one. The chances of getting selected depend not just on one's performance but also on how the performance is in relation to others who write the exam.

We need to understand the importance of even a single question in the CAT. An extra correctly-done question means three more marks and these three marks will make a very significant difference to your percentile score. This means that even two or three more questions correctly answered could make or break your chances.

But, how to make sure that one gets these three additional questions? That would require two key aspects.

- i) Focussed and appropriately guided preparation which makes sure that students do not spend time on unnecessary topics but also spend enough time on the necessary ones.
- ii) Appropriate test taking strategy coupled with regular feedback on their performance in relation with the competition.

Those relying on free/cheap prep help that is available online would miss out on both these aspects as they would lack the necessary hand-holding to guide them through the right kind of preparation and instead go through whatever is freely available. Equally important is the fact that such resources do not provide the regular and detailed performance feedback which will enable students to make the essential changes in their preparation and move closer to maximising their score. Hence they would not be equipped to get those additional questions. This is true for all percentile levels, and results in under-achievement. Students, unfortunately, realise this very late after having wasted a valuable year with such resources.

At **T.I.M.E.**, on the other hand, with <u>our 3+ decades</u> of experience in understanding the CAT exam, students would get ample hand-holding on both the points mentioned above, drastically improving their chances of securing the best possible percentiles. 


