US, Israel quit UNESCO citing bias

The United States and Israel officially quit the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) with the close of 2018.

Qatar will cease to be a member of OPEC

Qatar will cease to be a member of the Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries. The country had sent an official notification to the OPEC expressing its wish to pull out and to focus on its liquefied natural gas production in December.

Ireland to seek EU aid over Brexit

Ireland government stated that it will seek hundreds of millions of euros in aid from the EU if Britain crashes out of the EU without a deal.

Pakistan abolishes visa on arrival for Afghans

Pakistan abolished the long-standing facility of visa on arrival for Afghan nationals.

France to ban participation in unauthorised protests: PM French Prime Minister Edouard Philippe has announced plans to punish people who hold unsanctioned protests after seven weeks of anti-government unrest.

India takes over operations of Chabahar port in Iran India has taken over operations of the strategic Chabahar port in the Sistan-Balochistan province of Iran's southern coast. This is the first time India will be operating a port outside its territory.

India, Norway to collaborate on SDGs, ocean economy India and Norway agreed to closely collaborate on ocean economy and achieving the Sustainable Development Goals, while also vowing to step up cooperation in combating terrorism. The two countries signed an MoU for holding an India-Norway Ocean Dialogue and decided to establish a joint task force on blue economy.

UK PM Theresa May wins no-confidence vote

British Prime Minister Theresa May has won a confidence vote, a day after her government suffered a parliamentary defeat over her Brexit deal with the European Union (EU). Ms. May won by 325 votes to 306 - a majority of 19, averting a general election.

India will host the 14th session of the Conference of Parties to the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD) to address the issue of land degradation and desertification which will have participation from over 100 countries.

World Economic Forum begins in Davos

The annual meet of the World Economic Forum (WEF) begun in Davos, Switzerland. World leaders from across the globe will assemble to the ski resort town on the Swiss Alps for five days to discuss issues related to global economy.

India signs 11 MoUs with Afghan government worth \$9.5 million

India has signed 11 MoUs valuing \$9.5 million with Afghanistan. The MoUs signed were for infrastructure, public services such as health clinics and governance related projects.

Venezuela announces breaking off diplomatic ties with US Venezuelan President Nicolas Maduro has announced that he is breaking off diplomatic ties with the United States after his American counterpart Donald Trump recognized opposition leader Juan Guaido as the South American country's interim President.

The ancient Neemrana Baori in Rajasthan's Alwar district; the Group of Temples at Ranipur Jharail in Odisha's Bolangir; and the Vishnu Temple in Kotali, Pithoragarh district, Uttarkhand, are the three other monuments that have been listed.
