Protests Resume in Madagascar Capital

In Madagascar, police fired tear gas as hundreds of young protesters returned to the streets of the capital, Antananarivo, despite President Andry Rajoelina agreeing to dissolve his government.

US Government Shuts Down Amid Funding Deadlock The US government has shut down after Congress failed to agree on a funding deal, with Republicans and Democrats at odds over subsidies for Obamacare. The deadlock is expected to cause federal worker layoffs, though essential services will continue.

Death toll rises to 72 in Cebu earthquake

The death toll from the magnitude 6.9 earthquake that struck Cebu province in the central Philippines has risen to 72.

ANO Party Wins Czech Parliamentary Elections

Populist billionaire Andrej Babiš's ANO party has secured a decisive victory in the Czech parliamentary elections, winning 35.5% of the vote with nearly all ballots counted.

Japan Declares Nationwide Flu Epidemic

Japan has declared a nationwide flu epidemic after over 4,000 cases were reported across the country. Around 3,000 hospitals recorded a total of 4,030 flu patients.

Clashes Escalate Along Pakistan-Afghanistan Border Intense clashes erupted along the Pakistan-Afghanistan border after Taliban forces attacked Pakistani military posts, following a recent Pakistani airstrike in Kabul.

North Korea Unveils Hwasong-20, Its Most Powerful ICBM North Korea unveiled its latest and most powerful intercontinental ballistic missile (ICBM), Hwasong-20, at a military parade led by Kim Jong Un.

International Peace Summit in Egypt to End Gaza War An international peace summit was convened in Egypt's Sharm el-Sheikh to finalise an agreement aimed at ending the war in Gaza. US President Donald Trump and Egyptian President Abdel Fattah el-Sisi co-chaired the meeting.

Seychelles opposition leader wins presidential race Seychelles opposition leader, Patrick Herminie, has won the country's presidential race, defeating incumbent leader Wavel Ramkalawan in a run-off vote.

US and Egypt, Qatar and Turkey Sign Declaration to End War and Bring Peace to Gaza

US President Donald Trump and the leaders of Egypt, Qatar and Turkey have signed a declaration for bringing peace to Gaza at a summit in the Egyptian resort of Sharm el- Sheikh.

First Release of Israeli Hostages from Gaza Begins Under Ceasefire Plan

The first release of living Israeli hostages from Gaza has begun as part of the first phase of the ceasefire plan in the Israel-Hamas war. Hamas has released seven hostages to the Red Cross. 20 living hostages will be exchanged for more than 1,900 Palestinian prisoners held by Israel.

EU Launches New Entry/Exit System for Non-EU Travellers Travellers from non-EU countries, including India, must now comply with the European Union's new Entry/Exit System (EES), which mandates fingerprinting, facial recognition, and digital passport scans at borders across the Schengen Zone.

India Elected Unopposed to UN Human Rights Council for 2026–28 Term

India has been elected unopposed to the Human Rights Council for the seventh time for a three-year term (2026-28) starting next year. The Human Rights Council is the main UN body with 47 members

Floods in South Sudan Affect 8.9 Lakh People

Nearly 8 lakh 90 thousand people have been affected by floods in South Sudan. Widespread flooding in the country has killed 19 people so far.

European Commission President survives two noconfidence votes in European Parliament

European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen has survived two vote of no-confidence motions as centrist parties backed her presidency. The motions, filed by the far-right and the far-left groups in the European Parliament, were debated on Monday and voted.

Madagascar Military Announces Seizure of State Power Madagascar's military has announced seizure of state power. A Malagasy military officer Colonel Michael Randrianirina announced that state power in Madagascar has been taken over by a military council.

IUCN World Conservation Congress concludes

The IUCN World Conservation Congress was concluded in Abu Dhabi after a week of high-level deliberations that shaped a renewed global conservation agenda. The congress unveiled the Abu Dhabi Call to Action, outlining IUCN's 20-year vision and four-year program centered on climate resilience, biodiversity recovery, and nature-positive innovation.

Brazil Announces Strategic Alliance with India

EU to Ban All Russian Energy Imports from January 2028 European Union countries have agreed to ban all Russian energy imports from January 2028. Energy ministers of EU countries have voted in favour of a draft regulation, which applies to both pipeline oil and liquefied natural gas supplied by Russia to EU countries.

US, Australia Sign \$8.5 Billion Agreements on Minerals and Defence

The United States and Australia have signed landmark agreements worth 8.5 billion US dollars, focused on critical minerals and defence cooperation.
