#### China Unveils Advanced Military Technology in **Beijing Parade**

In a historic first, China has publicly unveiled some of its most advanced military technology, including hypersonic missiles, electronic warfare systems, and unmanned combat platforms, during a massive military parade in central Beijing

#### S.Korea Pledges \$350 Billion Investment in Strategic U.S. Industries

South Korea's pledge to invest \$350 billion in strategic U.S. industries as part of a trade deal with Washington is likely to be led by state policy institutions that will provide funding on a case-by-case basis.

#### Nepal: Several dead as Gen Z protests turn violent In Nepal, the death toll from the Gen Z protests against corruption and the government's social media ban has climbed to 19, while more than 340 people have been injured across the country in clashes between protesters and police. The protest erupted following a nationwide ban on unregistered social media platforms

#### Nepal Withdraws Ban on Social Media After Violent **Youth Protests**

The Nepal government has withdrawn its earlier decision to ban social media sites after violent protests by youths that left at least 19 people dead and over 300 injured.

#### Norway's Labour Party wins the 2025 elections.

The Norwegian Labour Party has won the parliamentary election and will remain in power for another four years. After counting about 99% of the votes, the Labour Party won 89 seats in Parliament, while the opposition rightwing bloc had 80 seats.

#### Sri Lanka passes bill abolishing special privileges to former Presidents

Sri Lanka's Supreme Court has cleared a bill that seeks to abolish special privileges enjoyed by former presidents. The legislation, titled the Presidents' Entitlements (Repeal) Bill, repeals the 1986 Act under which ex-presidents and their widows received statefunded housing, transport, staff and secretarial allowances

#### India Votes in Favour of UN Resolution Backing Two-State Solution for Palestine

India has voted in favour of a resolution in the UN General Assembly that endorses the 'New York Declaration' on the peaceful settlement of the Palestine issue and implementation of the two-state solution. The resolution was introduced by France.

#### US President Trump Urges NATO to Stop Russian Oil **Purchases**

US President Donald Trump has called on all NATO countries to halt purchases of Russian oil, while warning of 50-100% tariffs on China due to its ties with Russia. He stated that the tariffs would be lifted once the Ukraine war ends.

U.S., South Korea, Japan open joint air and naval exercise The United States, South Korea and Japan opened an air and naval exercise named "Freedom Edge" off a South Korean island on September 15, 2025.

### North Korea declares nuclear statehood 'enshrined

permanently'
North Korea has stated that its status as a nuclear-armed state is "permanently enshrined" in its law and "irreversible", condemning the United States for demanding its denuclearisation.

#### UK and US Announce Major Nuclear Power Deals

The governments of the UK and the US have announced a wide-ranging series of nuclear power deals in which multiple leading US-based companies will build projects overseas. As part of the nuclear renaissance, the deals are specifically designed to accelerate advanced reactor deployment and reduce reliance on Russian nuclear fuel.

Russia, Belarus conduct tactical nuclear launch drills Russia has practised launching cruise missiles over the Russia has practised launifing cruise missiles over the Barents Sea during joint military exercises with Belarus codenamed Zapad (West). About 7,000 soldiers, including 6,000 Belarusians, have participated in the exercises held in Belarus and Russia.

**Israel launches ground assault on Gaza City**Thousands of Palestinians are fleeing Gaza City as Israel launches a ground invasion, escalating the conflict in one of the world's most densely populated regions.

#### Pakistan and Saudi Arabia Sign Strategic Defence Deal

Pakistan and Saudi Arabia have signed a major defence pact named "Strategic Mutual Defense Agreement" under which any aggression against either country shall be considered as an act of aggression against both.

### Trump signs proclamation imposing \$1,00,000 fee for

H-1B visa applications
U.S., President Donald Trump has signed a proclamation that will raise the fee for H-1B visas to a staggering \$1,00,000 annually, the latest in the administration's efforts to crack down on immigration.

#### Nations ratify the world's first treaty to protect international waters

The High Seas Treaty, a major agreement to protect marine diversity in the high seas was struck on September 19, 2025 when Morocco became the 60th nation to sign on, paving the way for the treaty to take effect next year.

### **US Vetoes UN Security Council Resolution Calling for** Gaza Ceasefire The US has, for the sixth time has vetoed a draft

resolution at the United Nations Security Council that would have demanded an immediate and permanent ceasefire in Gaza and the release of hostages.

Pakistan says its nuclear programme can be made available to Saudi Arabia
Pakistan's Defence Minister Khawaja Asif has said his country's nuclear capabilities could be extended to Saudi Arabia under a new mutual defence pact, marking the first time that Islamabad has openly acknowledged placing the kingdom under its nuclear umbrella.

#### India, Canada NSAs Hold Talks to Strengthen Security Cooperation

National Security Adviser Ajit Doval met his Canadian counterpart, Nathalie Drouin, in New Delhi to discuss enhancing bilateral security cooperation. Both sides acknowledged growing momentum to rebuild trust and expand collaboration at the highest political levels.

#### Australia, Canada and U.K. formally recognise Palestinian statehood

Canada, the United Kingdom and Australia have announced to formally recognise the State of Palestine, days after the United Nations General Assembly overwhelmingly endorsed a resolution calling for a two-state solution for Israel and Palestine.

#### Trilateral meeting of AU, EU, UN reiterates support for multilateralism

Leaders of the African Union (AU), the European Union (EU) and the United Nations (UN) met at the UN Headquarters in New York. The three organisations reiterating support for multilateralism as the most effective way to address today's challenges, condemned the rising number of instances of lack of respect for international law

#### French head formally announces to recognise the State of Palestine

French President Emmanuel Macron has formally announced to recognise the State of Palestine at the 80th United Nations General Assembly session in New York.

#### Pakistani Air Force conducts airstrike in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, 30 killed

The Pakistani Air Force has conducted an airstrike in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province, killing 30 people, including women and children.

#### High-level Debate of 80th Session of UN General Assembly begins

The high-level Debate of the 80th session of the United Nations General Assembly was held in New York.. This year's theme is "Better together: 80 years and more for peace, development and human rights.

#### 7th Future Food Forum 2025 opened in Dubai

The 7th Future Food Forum 2025 was held in Dubai, bringing together policymakers, industry leaders, and academics to explore pathways for advancing food security, trade, and innovation across the Global South.

#### Super Typhoon Ragasa wreaks havoc across South-East Asia

Super Typhoon Ragasa has wreaked havoc in Taiwan, Hong Kong, the Philippines and South China, causing severe flooding and destruction of infrastructure. 17 people died and 18 were injured in Taiwan due to Typhoon Ragasa.

#### Trump Signs Order Approving TikTok Deal

President Donald Trump has signed an executive order approving a deal that could keep TikTok alive in the U.S, easing national security concerns and paving the Way for American ownership of the popular app. TikTok's Chinese parent company will retain only a minority stake, while U.S. investors are set to hold about 80 per cent under a new joint venture.

#### US President Announces New Tariffs on Imported Drugs, Trucks, and Furniture

President Donald Trump has announced a new wave of tariffs, including a 100 per cent tax on imported branded drugs unless the company builds manufacturing plants in the US. He also unveiled a 25 per cent tariff on heavy-duty trucks and a 50 per cent levy on kitchen and bathroom cabinets to shield American industries from what he calls a "flooding" of foreign products.

#### Russia reiterates its support for India's bid for a permanent seat in UNSC

Russia has reiterated its support for India's bid for a permanent seat in the United Nations Security Council (UNSC). At the 80th session of the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA), Russian Foreign Minister, Sergey Lavrov emphasised the need for reform in the UNSC to reflect the current global landscape.

### US President, Israeli PM Announce Proposal for Gaza

United States President Donald Trump has announced a ceasefire plan for the conflict in Gaza, after meeting with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. The peace plan included that Gaza will be a de-radicalised, terrorfree zone that does not pose a threat to its neighbours and will be redeveloped for the benefit of the people of Gaza, who have suffered more than enough.

Nepal Imposes Travel Ban on Former PM KP Sharma Oli Nepal has imposed travel bans on ousted Prime Minister KP Sharma Oli as part of an investigation into deadly protest, which killed at least 73 people earlier this month.

#### Indian Army tests combat readiness in Arunachal Pradesh

The Indian Army has conducted Exercise Yudh Kaushal 3.0 in the high-altitude Kameng region of Arunachal Pradesh, showcasing its preparedness for next-generation warfare in extreme Himalayan conditions.

Over 7,000 CBI graft cases await trial in courts: CVC According to the latest annual report of the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC), as many as 7,072 corruption cases probed by the CBI were pending trial in different courts, with 379 of them for over 20 years.

Centre tweaks norms on tree plantation-based green credits In a new set of rules, the Union Environment Ministry will now award green credits generated for tree plantation under the Green Credit Programme (GCP) only after five years, based on a minimum canopy density of 40 per cent and tree survival.

#### India's First Multi-Lane Free Flow (MLFF) Tolling System in Gujarat

The Indian Highways Management Company Limited (IHMCL), a company promoted by NHAI has signed an agreement with ICICI Bank, to implement country's first comprehensive Multi-Lane Free Flow (MLFF) tolling system at Choryasi Fee Plaza in Gujarat on NH-48.

#### OpenAl plans India data centre

ChatGPT parent OpenAI is scouting for local partners to set up a data centre in India with at least 1 gigawatt capacity.

#### Centre launches advanced biomanufacturing hubs

The Centre has launched a network of advanced biomanufacturing hubs to scale up the country's bioeconomy and accelerate innovation across diverse sectors. The High- Performance Bio manufacturing Platforms, an initiative of the Department of Biotechnology (DBT) and the Biotechnology Industry Research Àssistance Council (BIRAC)

## Home Ministry Reiterates Passport and Visa Exemption for Nepal, Bhutan Citizens

The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has clarified that citizens of Nepal and Bhutan entering India by land or air will continue to be exempted from furnishing passports or visas, as per earlier practice. The exemption was notified under the Immigration and Foreigners (Exemption) Order, 2025.

### India's first indigenous 32-bit microprocessor Vikram chip, unveiled

India has built its first space-grade computer chip for rockets, called Vikram 3201. It is the country's first indigenous 32-bit microprocessor designed to survive the extreme conditions of space launches. The chip was designed by ISRO Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre and made at the government's Semi-Conductor Laboratory (SCL) in Chandigarh.

### Governors cannot sit over Bills endlessly, say Supreme Court judges

Three of the five judges on the Presidential Reference Bench have orally observed, along with the States of Tamil Nadu and West Bengal, that Governors cannot sit endlessly over Bills placed before them for assent.

### India, Singapore Deepen Defence Tech Cooperation in Al, Quantum Computing, and Unmanned Vessels

India and Singapore have agreed to deepen defence technology cooperation in emerging areas such as Quantum Computing, Al, Automation and Unmanned Vessels.

### Modi, Wong inaugurate Phase Two of Mumbai container terminal project

Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his Singapore counterpart Lawrence Wong virtually inaugurated Bharat Mumbai Container Terminal Phase-2 (PSA Mumbai Phase-2) developed by Singapore's PSA International at the Jawaharlal Nehru Port Authority (JNPA) in Navi Mumbai.

#### INS Trikand reaches Egypt to join multilateral drill Bright Star 2025

Indian naval stealth frigate INS Trikand arrived at Alexandria in Egypt as part of her operational deployment to the Mediterranean Sea. The warship took part in Exercise Bright Star 2025, a major multilateral drill hosted by Egypt from September 1 to 10.

### IIT-Madras secures top spot in NIRF Rankings 2025

IIT-Madras and Indian Institute of Science (IISc) in Bengaluru have bagged the first and second positions in the overall National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) ranking for 2025. IIT Madras also topped the Engineering institutions category.

Among Universities, IISc Bangalore retained its top spot for the tenth year in a row.

Meanwhile, the Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad, topped the Management institutions category.

Further, AIIMS, Delhi, topped the Medical category.

While in the Law institutions category, the first rank was achieved by National Law School of India University, Bengaluru.
