<u>European Union rules requiring all new smartphones, tablets and cameras to use same C-type charger comes into force.</u>

European Union rules requiring all new smartphones, tablets and cameras to use the same charger came into force.

The EU said it will cut costs and waste. Manufacturers are now obliged to fit devices sold in the 27-nation bloc with a USB-C, the port chosen by the European Union as the common standard for charging electronic tools. The EU has said the single charger rule will simplify the life of Europeans and slash costs for consumers.

Russia declares federal emergency over Black Sea oil spill.

Russia warned of severe environmental damage from a huge oil spill in the Black Sea caused when two tankers collided in a storm near Crimea, which declared a state of emergency.

Two Russian-flagged oil tankers were severely damaged during a storm near the Kerch Strait, leading to the release of thousands of tons of heavy fuel oil, known as mazut, into the Black Sea. The spill has polluted approximately 55 kilometers (34 miles) of coastline.

ISRO to launch Space Docking Experiment SpaDeX.

Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is set to launch its Space Docking Experiment, SpaDeX.

ISRO's year-end mission will be a historic one as it will seek the rare feat of docking or merging two satellites in space.

SpaDeX mission will mark India's entry into the exclusive league of nations capable of mastering space docking. The PSLV rocket, will launch two satellites equipped with indigenous technology, the 'Bhartiya Docking System,' to demonstrate this complex feat.

RBI allows PPI holders to have UPI transactions

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has permitted to enable UPI payments from/to full-KYC Prepaid Payment Instruments (PPIs) through third-party UPI applications like Google Pay and PhonePe as per its previous announcement made in the Statement on Development and Regulatory Policies.

Previously, UPI payments were limited to bank accounts or PPI issuers' applications, restricting user flexibility. This change marks a significant step towards achieving a unified digital payment ecosystem, reducing dependency on specific platforms.
