International

New Chief Justice of Sri Lanka

Justice Murdu Nirupa Bindushini Fernando became the 48th Chief Justice of Sri Lanka and the second woman to hold this position. Justice Fernando succeeds Justice Jayantha Jayasuriya, who recently retired. Her appointment received approval from the Constitutional Council.

<u>United Nations Convention to Combat</u> Desertification

The world's largest United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification began in Riyadh on December 2, bringing together an unprecedented gathering of global leaders, policymakers, and environmental experts. This critical conference, running from December 2nd to 13th, aims to accelerate action on land restoration and drought resilience worldwide.

International Day of Persons with Disabilities 2024

On the occasion of International Day of Persons with Disabilities 2024, President Droupadi Murmu will confer the National Awards for Empowering Persons with Disabilities to thirty-three exemplary individuals and institutions in New Delhi on December 3, 2024.

Social Justice and Empowerment Minister Dr. Virendra Kumar will also unveil sixteen transformative initiatives, on the occasion, aimed at enriching the lives of persons with disabilities. These initiatives span inclusivity, innovation, and technology, reinforcing the department's commitment to empowerment. Some of the key initiatives include the launch of the 'Kadam Knee Joint, 'Pathways to Access: Part III, and the Braille Book Portal.

<u>Case study by Oxford's Said Business School</u> on the PRAGATI scheme

A new case study by Oxford's Said Business School released at IIM Bangalore today revealed that since its launch in 2015, PRAGATI(Pro-Active Governance and Timely Implementation) has helped accelerate 340 projects worth 205 billion dollars. The Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) has witnessed tremendous growth in April to September 2024

The Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) has witnessed a surge of 45 percent to over 29 billion dollars from April to September this year as compared to the same period last year. As per the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), the main sectors of the economy that benefited from the FDI include services, computer software and hardware, telecom, automobile, pharmaceuticals and chemicals.

The Ayush sector has registered tremendous growth

In the last decade, the Ayush sector has registered tremendous growth and the market of Ayush sector has surpassed 43 billion dollars in 2023 as per Union Minister of State for Power and New and Renewable Energy, Shripad Yesso Naik. Mr Naik said that International Yoga Day is now celebrated in most countries across the globe and it reflects the country's soft power. He said the export sector has also jumped from 1.09 billion dollars in 2014 to 2.16 billion dollars in 2023.
